A special THANK YOU! to **Jessica Damanski**, a TCNJ Bonner Scholar who has worked with our participants over the course of the last three years.

Jess showed up without fail for meal delivery every week - which eventually led up to her organizing a TCNJ van for Monday through Friday meal delivery, along with providing training to other Bonner Scholars.



Jess also provided invaluable program support. She quickly showed a unique sensitivity and ability for connecting with our participants, which led to her assisting with well-checks and nutrition risk assessments.

During Jess' senior year, she modeled her legacy project after the "Music and Memory" program that is proven to benefit those coping with dementia, and led to her designing a music therapy program for our participants. She helped acquire a community partner grant for the program, which funded MP3 players based on direct feedback from participants and their families.

Ruth Todd, MOWMC Director of Program Services, was recently able to present Jess with an award honoring her dedicated service. She noted:
