Meals on Wheels of Mercer County (MOWMC) is hosting the **Paws for Our Cause Walk & Family Wellness Fair** on October 19, 2024, beginning at 1PM at Rosedale Park in Pennington, NJ. The Walk & Family Wellness Fair will be raising essential funds to support the Meals on Wheels of Mercer County (MOWMC) senior nutrition program and Pet Pantry. Meals on Wheels of Mercer County feeds nearly 600 homebound seniors per year, as well as their pets. According to Ms. Keyes-Maloney, "MOWMC not only ensures our seniors receive essential nutrition, they also help ensure they are not alone – through the visits their volunteers provide and maybe as importantly, ensuring they can keep their beloved pets. Research shows that pets have many health benefits for older adults, including improved cognitive, mental and physical health. I am so proud to be able to be part of making this a reality." The MOWMC Pet Pantry supplies pet food to program participants who need it - keeping seniors and their pets healthy, happy AND together!

Family members of all ages can participate in pet-related activities and other activities that encourage a healthy lifestyle. Programs on this day will include Pet Costume Contest, Pet food collection, family exercise demos, nutritional counseling, music, basket auction, pet adoption with Easel, and much more!

Co-Chair Michael Cucciniello urges the community to join come out and enjoy the days with us and support our important services, "Poems are constructed not only with words but also from the spaces between words. This is true for our relationships with other people, and it is also true for their connection to their family members, their pets."
